

Bug report Sept. 30, 2008:

Filled-Tab Test, Pagestream Amiga 4.15.6 1/30/03

With Amiga char-set:

- Filled tabs do not work when printing postscript to disk with fonts either embedded or non-embedded.
- Filled tabs do not work when creating a pdf doc via “Save as pdf”.
- Manually filled tabs doesn’t work as above
- Manually filled tabs when filled from the right changes the tab position
- With tracking off and proportionate font doesn’t work as above
- With tracking off and tab as courier font doesn’t work as above
- Filled tabs as text objects do not work
- Filled tabs work when printing to laserjet4 compatible printer.
- Filled tabs work on screen.

With Amiga char-set and smart dashes/bullets off:same as above.

With Windows char-set and smart dashes/bullets off: no difference.

Work-around: Use Courier (dmf) for the fill-tab characters and use \8228 as the fill char.
